Our April 14, 2018 concert will feature special guest pianist, Dr. Tomasz Robak.



Dr. Robak completed his undergraduate studies at Rice University, graduating magna cum laude with degrees in both piano and philosophy, and a Distinction in Creative Works and Research. He completed a Master of Music degree in piano performance at the Peabody Institute, where he is currently completing a Doctor of Musical Arts degree. His principal teachers have been Dr. Robert Roux, Benjamin Pasternack, Alexander Shtarkman (piano) and Donald Sutherland, Jeremy Filsell (organ).

In addition to performing, Dr. Robak is a passionate educator. He is a member of the piano faculty at the Peabody Preparatory, is in his fifth year serving as a Graduate Assistant in Keyboard Studies at the Peabody Conservatory.

Dr. Robak has received scholarships from the Kosciuszko Foundation and the Polish American Arts Association of Washington, DC. In 2013, he took Second Prize at the International Beethoven Sonata Competition in Memphis.
